# VI. Legislation Update: Presented by Linda Ceballos

- 1. **AB 179** Budget includes \$180,000,000 of Greenhouse Gas Reductions Funds for local agency grants to implement SB 1383; \$73,300,000 for start-up bottle and can redemption including reverse vending machines, bag drop and mobile recycling programs (Signed by Governor)
- 2. **AB 661** Updates the State Agency Buy Recycled Campaign with new recycled content standards for materials purchased by the state of California (Passed)
- 3. **AB 1857** Repeals provision of law that allows jurisdictions to count up to 10% of the waste sent to waste-to-energy facilities toward their 50% diversion requirement (Signed by Governor)
- 4. **AB 1985** Reduces local organics procurement goals to 30% of target amount in 2023; 65% in 2024; 100% thereafter (Signed by Governor)
- 5. **AB 2440** Establishes an extended producer responsibility program for most batteries (Signed by Governor)
- 6. **AB 2784** Specifies recycled content standards for thermoform plastic food containers (Vetoed by Governor)
- 7. **SB 54** Creates an EPR program for printed paper and plastic packaging and sets recycling rates and reductions for plastics (Signed by Governor)
- 8. **SB 1013** Expands container redemption program to include wine and distilled spirits (Passed)
- 9. **SB 1046** Bans plastic produce bags (Passed)
- 10.**SB 1215** Adds battery-embedded products to the state's e-waste program (Signed by Governor)
- 11. **SB 1256** Prohibits sale of disposal propane cylinders beginning 2028 (Passed)
