Q: What is ePro and what do I need to register in ePro?

A: eProcurement Network (ePro) is utilized to better communicate business opportunities between the County and its Vendors. ePro. allows vendors to access solicitation information electronically and enabes vendors to submit bids and proposals electronically.

Q: I am registered in ePro, does that mean I am pre-qualified?

A: No, registering in ePro only gives vendors access to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) document. In addition to registering in ePro, vendors must complete the RFQ process to become pre-qualified. Once a vendor is pre-qualified there is no need to resubmit a proposal until contract expires. Please refer to the schedule above for RFQ release dates.

Q: Do I have to provide pricing when I submit a proposal?

A: No, pricing is not required to pre-qualify as a pre-approved vendor. Pricing will be requested at the time a Request for Bid is released.

Q: How do I receive a Request for Bid?

A: Complete the RFQ process, if vendors meet the minimum qualifications a contract will be awarded, and vendors will be added to a short list of pre-approved material/service providers. As projects are identified, pre-approved vendors will be sent a request for bid via email detailing the job date, location, quantity, and any other special requirements.
