VII. Legislation Update: Presented by Linda Ceballos

AB 1526 Resources. Adds aerosol spray paint to the Paint Care program and makes non-controversial changes to SB 54. *Approved by Governor 10/14/23.*

SB 244 Right to Repair Act. Right to Repair would require that electronics and appliance product manufacturers make parts, tools and diagnostic information, including software locks, available to consumers and independent repair shops. *Approved by Governor 10/10/23.*

SB 353 Bottle Bill Expansion. Expands the California Bottle Bill program to include 46 oz. juice containers and larger. Also adjusts the processing payment formula used by CalRecycle to support recycling centers. *Approved by Governor 10/13/23.*

SB 568 Electronic waste: export Requires exporters of covered electronic waste or a covered electronic device to demonstrate that the material could not be managed by an in-state e-waste recycler. *Approved by Governor 10/04/23*.
