Surplus Material permits that exceed 10,000 cubic yards are processed through San Bernardino County Flood Control District Permits Division open proposal process.

Proposers are required to attend the Job Walk in order to submit a proposal, typically due one week after solicitation. Proposals will include but not be limited to the quantity of material to be removed, the unit price, past performance with the District, and the anticipated duration of removal. The District will use these factors to evaluate and select the proposer who can provide the best service to the District. The District will continue to charge the applicable filing and inspection fees.
