- III. Metro STOR Pilot Project: Presented by Tim Henry and Nigel Deacon
 - Presentation goal: Increase awareness among San Bernardino County cities about current case studies and data collection pilot projects using access-controlled organics and recycling infrastructure.
 - Several pilots are in partnership with Circular Action Alliance (CAA) and The Recycling Partnership (TRP) to collect multifamily recycling and organics data for CAA's SB54 2027 Action Plan.
 - Noted that CAA must increase recycling volumes in California and reduce contamination in the recycling stream.
 - CalRecycle leadership is aware of the infrastructure and has invited the team to apply for a presentation slot at the next CRRA conference.

- A. John Davis mentioned some additional nitrous oxide bills – SB 758, AB 2076, and SB 936
 - B. Susan Shaker mentioned SB 922 related to franchise fees not being able to be used for street repairs.

- A. John asked if he could see more details for the Freepoint Eco-Systems project—question to be asked of Noah.
